# How to apply.

Once you have decided that you would like to study with us, our aim is to make the application process as efficient and straightforward as possible. In order for us to consider your application, you will need to send us the following documentation:

- Copies of all your academic qualifications.
   If you have not yet completed these, you will need to state this on your application form and send us your results once you have them
- Proof of English Language competence.
   Please see page 8 for details
- A personal statement explaining why you would like to study your chosen course and what you plan to do with your qualification
- A reference or letter of recommendation from one of your teachers explaining your academic potential.

#### There are two main ways to apply:

#### 1. Online application

Applicants for undergraduate courses can apply online via the University and Colleges Admissions Services at **ucas.com**

#### 2. Using an approved in-country representative

All in-country representatives are familiar with our courses and our application procedures. Many have visited the University or are University of Northampton graduates, and can therefore provide first-hand information. ## Accommodation.

It's never easy to leave home for the first time, so you need to know that when you arrive at university you won't have to worry about where you'll be living. With over 2,500 bed spaces, our Halls of Residence offer all you need to relax, make friends, socialise and study.

#### **On-campus**

Our new Student Village is just a few metres from the academic buildings where you will be learning. You might choose one of the five-storey flats, or perhaps you would prefer one of the four-storey townhouses with landscaped courtyards.

#### Off-campus

While most students love the convenience of living on-campus during their first year, we also offer a wide range of off-campus rooms to suit all budgets. St John's Hall of Residences is located in the heart of Northampton town centre, just a short walk from campus, whilst our other two off-campus suburban locations offer a free weekday bus service to campus.

#### What's the deal?

Rents range from as little as £77 per person, per week, to £165\*. Your contract is for 43 weeks and, wherever you choose, your accommodation will be fully furnished with all utilities and a basic insurance policy included – so no surprise costs. Your room will have University computer network and WiFi access but you will have to pay for a TV licence if you bring a TV for your room. We take your safety seriously, so all sites have 24-hour security and a dedicated support team.

#### **Private sector accommodation**

Many of our students live off-campus in private rented accommodation. Our Student Lets Team regularly updates a housing list with details of available properties that meet our high safety standards. You can expect to pay between £70 and £90 per week, depending on location and facilities.
